In a year of unprecedented challenges at the global level and a year of many achievements at a local level, the Rozelle Interchange Project took the opportunity to recognise how extremely fortunate we are to be in the position we are in, both as a project and as a nation.

While we have been very fortunate, there are many children, parents, families and individuals coming to terms with very different circumstances than they had this time last year.

With over 32,000 children who are in need this year, not to mention their families, the Rozelle Interchange Project took the time to raise money and donate gifts to give back to those who have had a particularly tough year with the fallout from the global pandemic.

The Project partnered with three local charities, supporting The Smith Family foundation with a toy and book appeal, the Balmain-based PCYC and Harding Miller Education Foundation.

To encourage our teams to give back, the Project pledged to match the first 200 gifts donated with a \$50 donation to PCYC Balmain and The Harding Miller Education Foundation

With a huge collaborative effort from staff, the community, subcontractors, our Independent Certifier, and Transport for New South Wales, we raised \$53,000 for the two local charities - PCYC Balmain and The Harding Miller Education Foundation. Additionally over 800 gifts were donated across our sites for The Smith Family's Toy and Book Appeal going out to disadvantaged Australian children this Christmas.

Through the kindness support and collaboration of everyone involved, we have been able to support those who need it most.
