

Rozelle Interchange Work Readiness Program

The Project created the Work Readiness Program, designed to provide participants with training, mentoring and employment support prior to placement on the Project. The Project engaged Indigenous Work Placement Provider, Goanna Services, to recruit and provide mentoring to assist participants through the program. The mentor provides a link between trainees, families, employers, supervisors, and third-party support agencies, to assist participants in their transition from training to employment. The three-week program features several training activities that lead to a formal qualification - Certificate II/III in Civil Construction and aims to improve employment opportunities in the Greater Western Sydney region and addresses projected skills shortages and construction industry growth. Upon the successful completion of the program, the participants were offered a full-time job opportunity on the Project which will provide invaluable experience learning from and working alongside the Project's talented team.
