

2021 trainees prepare for work on Rozelle Interchange Project

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The Rozelle Interchange Project will welcome the next cohort of school-based trainees from CathWest Innovation College in early 2021.

The school-based traineeship program launched in January 2020 and is committed to the learning and development of the next generation of construction workers. The program saw five Year 11 students work at designated construction sites, including the Rozelle Interchange Project, providing them with invaluable work experience in civil and tunnelling works.

The program's success prompted a surge in interest for the 2021 intake which will accommodate a larger group of students in the new year. The new cohort will see Year 11 and 12 students work across the Project alongside the Surface Works, Tunnelling, Finance, Human Resources and Commercial teams.

Similar to the 2020 program, the 2021 course will run over 12 - 24 months. The traineeship sees students complete their Higher School Certificate, a Certificate II in Construction or Business Administration with 1 - 2 years of valuable work experience under their belts at the time of finishing their final year of school.

These workplace experiences give trainees an insight into full-time employment and the various roles available in construction as well as the opportunity to network, learn and work alongside passionate industry professionals.

Trusted Registered Training Organisation, H&I Training generously supplied a barbeque lunch and merchandise to welcome the trainees.

Onboarding of the new trainees is well underway in preparation for their start in January 2021.
